

# The Desiccated Font



The Desiccated Font is located in a chapel bereft of worshipers for so long it has been dry for centuries. The font is so dry as to pull moisture into itself. Uncovered flesh touching it will feel as if burning as the water is drawn out. Fluids poured into it will disappear as fast as they are poured and affect the pourer in strange ways:

Liquid	Effect
Holy Water	Skin becomes pearlescent, hair becomes feathers, & a chance of functioning wings.
Water	Water breathing, 20% chance to fail when in combat.
Oil	See in the dark up to 60', but double damage from fire (normal if save).
Wine	Immune to fear, charm, & control, but loss of 1d6 dexterity.
Tears	Heals completely, restores lost limbs, lost senses, removes curses.
Tears of Another	Melancholia.
Blood	Become almost bloodless, decreases constitution by 1d6, but grants immunity to all blood draining attacks & magic that targets emotions.
Blood of Another	Hemophilia.
Blood of an Animal	For carnivorous animals– lycanthropy, for others– gain 2 stone & lose the ability to digest all but vegetation.
Saliva	Uncontrollable urge to eat anything in sight. Immune to ingested poisons.
Urine	Skin becomes horn-like & jaundiced, hair falls out & sexual organs wither away, but life lengthened by 100 years.
Unholy Water	No apparent effect, however, upon death chance to rise as a: vampire (20%), wight (50%), or ghoul (30%).
